How does it work?



1. Our customer orders the exchange package and, on an agreed date, sends a truck equipped with a crane to pick up the necessary exchange components at the Sandvik workshop.



2. In the meantime, our customers or Sandvik service personnel start dismantling the crusher. The truck arrives with the exchange package.

3. The crusher is assembled with the exchange program parts.

4. Our customer resumes with production shortly after installation. The truck returns the worn parts to the Sandvik workshop.



5. In the workshop, the exchange parts are changed or renovated, rapidly turned into a brand new exchange package.
